

Three Eye 2023/24 Season Notes:

Officers:

League President: Jim Berkenpas (Bole-Mor Lanes)

League Vice President: Steve Kor (Greg's Welding)

League Secretary & Treasurer: Taya DeRycke (Owner)

Fees:

One Time Sanction Fee \$15 (checks made out to Bole-Mor Lanes)

Weekly: \$16 (checks made out to Bole-Mor Lanes)

- \$13 for bowling alley

- \$2.50 for prize fund (divided amongst teams at the end of the year by treasurer)

- \$.25 for secretary duties

- \$.25 for treasurer duties

One Time Sponsorship Fee: \$50 (goes towards prize fund, checks made out to Three Eye)

Bowling:

Starts at 7:00

Thursday Nights

Taking off November 23rd, December 28th

27 weeks, split into thirds

- Position round on final week of every third

- Ties will be broken by a one frame roll off.

Roll off will take place on the Thursday after the 27th week of league (unless it needs to be rescheduled due to conflicts.)

Rules:

Dummy scores:

Dummy score will be 10 under absent bowler's average with handicap

If using a substitute as well as a dummy score, it is up to the team captain as to which absent bowler the substitute is used for.

If a team consists of more than 5 bowlers, the dummy score will go to the absent bowler with the highest number of games. If there is a tie for that, it will go to the bowler with the lower average.

If a bowler is late, they have a 3 frame allowance before receiving a dummy score for the current game. The dummy score must go to the late bowler in this case, and can not be changed to a different absent team member, even if they have a higher number of games.

Dummy scores are still required to be paid for.

Dummy scores may be used in either position rounds or the Roll Off. Maximum of 2.

Weekly Lineup:

5 bowlers per team will be used each week, a minimum of 3 must physically be present.

A maximum of 2 substitutes may be used in one night by a singular team.

Taya **must** be informed of that night's lineup (if different than the previous week's) **prior** to 5:00

If using a bowler who has not yet bowled in the current league season, Taya must be informed by at least 5:00 on the night of bowling.

Pre-Bowls/Make Ups:

If a team will be unable to bowl, it is up to that team to have someone notify the league secretary prior to 6:00 on the night they will be missing. If league starts and a full team is absent without notifying the secretary, they will forfeit unless there's an emergency.

Teams have a time span of one week before and one week after to either pre-bowl or make up for a missed week of bowling. This must be scheduled with Taya to ensure lanes are properly set up. Please arrange this in a timely manner to ensure lane availability.

Substitutes cannot be used for pre-bowls or make ups if they bowled with a different team on the regularly scheduled night.

If a team cannot pre-bowl or make up for a missed week in the allowed time frame, they will forfeit all 4 games. They are still responsible for paying their weekly fees, however.

A team must all pre-bowl or make up at one time. Substitutes and/or dummy scores may be used, but all 5 scores must come from the same bowling session.

Cancellations:

It is up to the league president to call off the league due to weather. If for some reason they are unable to make a decision, it is up to the league vice president to make the decision. Taya must be informed before 5:30 on the night of the league, and will contact all team captains, and post on social media. Team captains are responsible for informing their team members.

Missed weeks will be added onto the end of the schedule.

Roll Off:

Will include the winning team of each trimester, plus one wildcard team

The wildcard team will be determined by the team with the highest number of year-to-date wins that isn't already included in roll off, year-to-date pins will break ties.

If one team wins all three trimesters, we will not have a Roll Off.

If one team wins two trimesters, the third trimester winner and the wildcard team will bowl against each other in a one game roll off to determine who will go on to bowl against the majority winner.

Regular league rules will apply.

Teams will only pay the bowling alley fee (\$13) as opposed to the full weekly fee.

Substitutes may only be used in the Roll Off if they have bowled 21 games (7 weeks) with that team.

If there is a tie in the Roll Off it will be broken by a 10th frame.

Position Round:

Will take place in the final week of each trimester.

If there is a tie, it will be broken by a 10th frame Roll Off.

Other:

Lanes 1-8 will be used for the first half of the season, and 3-10 for the second half, swapping on week 13.

League bowlers must be 19+.

League may contain bowlers of any gender.

If a team leaves mid-season, they will forfeit any prize fund money. If they were the winning team of a trimester, the 2nd place team from that trimester will advance.
